1. My Account - Manage User accounts general settings.

1.1. Account Details:

Here user can view his Account details such as,

First Name

Last Name

Login Name

Email

1.2. Password Reset:

User can update his password from here. First enter the old password and then the new one. Then confirm the new password. After submission, the old password is updated to the new one. If the old password is incorrect, the update process will not work.

2. Manage VPS-Manage your VPS's general settings:

2.1. List VPS:

The VPS's with its details such as Container ID, VPS Name, Select VPS, Plan, Status are displayed here.

2.2. Start VPS:

User can start the stopped VPS by selecting the stopped VPS from the combo box. After the submission, the selected VPS will be started.

2.3. Stop VPS:

User can stop the started VPS by selecting the started VPS from the combo box. After the submission, the selected VPS will be stopped.

2.4. Reload OS:

User can reload the OS for a selected VPS. Select a VPS from the VPS list and desired OS from the OS list. After submission, OS will be reloaded for the selected VPS .

2.5. Reset Root Password:

User can change the password of a selected VPS. Select a VPS from the VPS list and enter the new password. After the confirmation and submission password updated.

3. Stats- Shows the performance of CPU, memory, bandwidth of VPS

3.1. VPS Bandwidth Usage:

Shows the bandwidth usage of a selected VPS in a particular interval through the graph.

3.2. VPS Load Average:

Shows the load average of a selected VPS in a particular interval through the graph.

3.3. VPS Memory:

Shows the memory usage of a selected VPS in a particular interval through the graph.

3.4. VPS CPU Usage:

Shows the CPU usage of a selected VPS in a particular interval through the graph.

4. Plugins- Shows the plugins used by the User Panel.

4.1. Vps Mini Status:

This shows the current status of the selected VPS. The status contains VPS name, IP, Time, Users and Load Average of the selected VPS.

4.2. Order Now:

User can order VPS's using this plugin.

4.3. cPanel/WHM:

These plugins are used for login to cPanel and WHM.

4.4. Plesk:

This plugin used for login to Plesk.

4.5. InterWorx:

This plugin used for login to NodeWorx and SiteWorx.

5. Backups-Manage User VPS's Backups:

5.1. Backup Status:

The VPS's Backup Status such as VPS Name,Backup Status, Backup Type are displayed here.

5.2. Configure Backups:

User can restore the backup of a selected VPS in Daily/Weekly basis.After submission the backup will restored to the selected time period.
